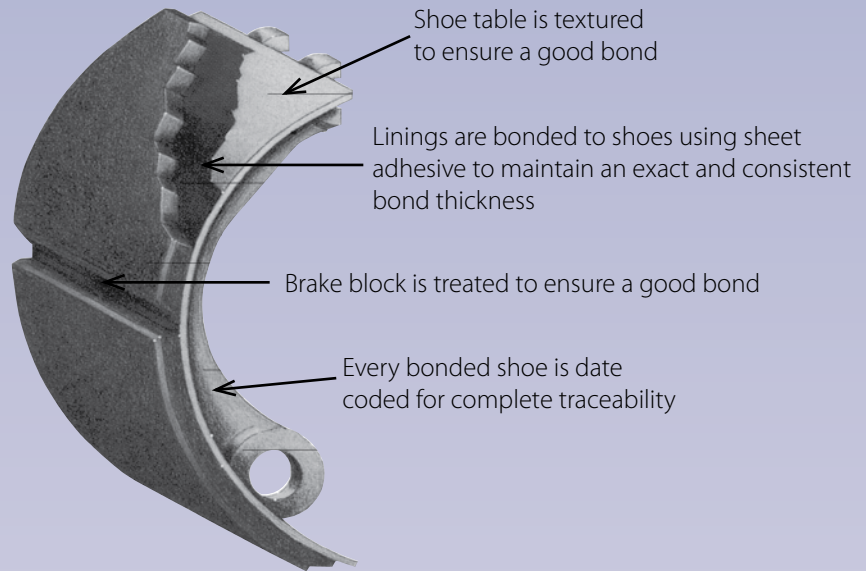

- What size **lining** do you want (standard, 1x, 2x, or 3x)?
- Do you want an **axle set** (4 shoe assemblies) or a **wheel set** (2 shoe assemblies)?
