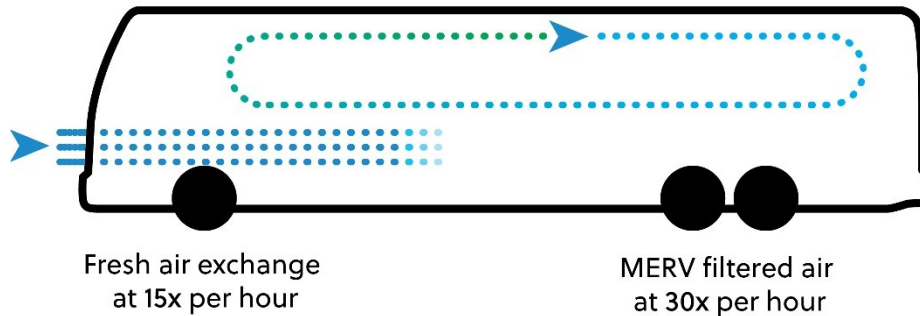


MCI FRESH AIR EXCHANGE RATE 15X ON ALL J AND D SERIES COACH MODELS

Fresh Air + Filtered Air = Clean Air



Ensuring proper ventilation with outside air can help reduce the concentration of airborne contaminants, including viruses, inside a coach. In keeping with CDC guidelines, MCI's coaches use a combination of fresh outside air as well as MERV filtered recirculated air to optimize cabin air quality. Every four minutes (15 times per hour), passenger cabin air is completely exchanged with fresh outside air. This update is based on recent testing and validation from MCI's engineering team. Simultaneously, all recirculated cabin air is filtered with MERV filter every two minutes (30 times per hour), which removes respiratory droplets and particles as small as 3 microns.
